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2nd ASEICA EDUCATIONAL SYMPOSIUM

Madrid, 28th - 29th November 2019

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The scientific committee invites you to participate in the contest of scientific abstracts of the 2nd ASEICA EDUCATIONAL SYMPOSIUM that will take place in Madrid on November 28th and 29th of 2019.

The submission of abstracts for the 2nd ASEICA EDUCATIONAL SYMPOSIUM implies acceptance of the following rules:

- Abstracts must be submitted online via the ASEICA abstract submission website: [LINK](#) (Click on here). Before submitting your abstract, you must first register in the section "New authors" and the system will ask you for a username and a password with which you will be able to: submit further abstracts, edit your abstracts until the submission deadline and edit your registration data. Then you can upload the abstract in the section "Submit Abstracts").
- The author or authors must consider that the content of the abstract is original and stemming from the direct activities of their research lab.
- All participants should state the topic in which their abstract must be included. Topics include:
 - o Genomic and signaling perspectives in cancer
 - o Targeted Therapies
 - o New Therapeutic Approaches: Immunotherapies
 - o Current Therapeutic Challenges and New Frontiers in Cancer
 - o Liquid Biopsy and other emerging technologies
 - o Other subjects (in this case, if selected for oral presentation, they will be included in some of the above topics based on the opinion of the Scientific Committee).
- The deadline for the submission of abstracts is on **Monday, 14th October 2019**.
- The **presenting** author must be a member of ASEICA. New ASEICA membership applicants will be also accepted. Abstracts will be only accepted upon full registration of the applicant in the Symposium.
- The authorship list of the abstract communication must be limited to a maximum of 10 individuals.

- The authors should indicate during the registration if they wish that abstract will be considered as a poster presentation or an oral communication.
- The deadline for the abstract of acceptance is **Thursday, 7th November 2019**.
- The first author must confirm the presentation of the project 48h after the foregoing date and must convey this information to the rest of collaborators.
- Selected abstracts will also be presented as oral communications. All abstracts will be candidates for the **ASEICA Best Communication Awards** (poster and oral communication categories)
- We inform you that the abstracts presented in the **II Encuentro de Jóvenes Investigadores del CIBERONC (IIEJI)** contest, can also be presented in the 2nd ASEICA Educational Symposium contest.
If you wish to do so, please the registration of these abstracts must be done following the process described in the rules of the Aseica contest.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS:

- All communications should be written in **English**.
- Do not write the title or authors on the space reserved for the abstract body.
- Graphs, images, tables, etc., will be uploaded as separate files with a limitation of 2 MB.
- Summaries should be no longer than 5,000 characters and will include: a brief introduction, objectives, method, results, and conclusions.
- The title should be no longer than 20 words.
- Select the category in which the abstract should be classified.
- Authors: please enter the first author in the first place (this will be the contact person with the Technical Secretariat)

RULES ON POSTERS

- If your abstract has been chosen as a poster, you must bring it printed on the **27th November 2019** (early morning).
- The size of the poster must be **120 cm high and 90 cm wide**.
- In the congress you will find an abstract list with the main authors' names and the number assigned to the scientific abstract.
- The posters will be exhibited during the entire duration of the Symposium.

RULES ON ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

- If the abstract is admitted, the first author will be the person in charge of making the presentation in English during the Congress.
- We will send to the first author an email indicating the duration time and the number of slides that will be used during the presentation.
- Only slides in either PowerPoint or PDF format will be accepted.
- The speaker will provide an USB containing his/her slide presentation to the technical secretariat of the Congress at least 1 hour before the beginning of the session.
