ASEICA is glad to invite you to participate in the Scientific Abstracts session of our **18th ASEICA International Congress**, that will take place in Santiago de Compostela from 16th to 18th of November 2022.

- The deadline for the Abstract submission is **October 3th, 2022**.

All abstracts will be candidates for the **ASEICA Best Communication Awards** (Poster and Oral Presentations).

Indications for abstract submission:

- Abstracts must be submitted online via the following ASEICA abstract submission [LINK](#).

Before submitting your abstract, you must first register in the section "New authors" and the system will ask you for a username and a password. You will be able to submit abstract(s), edit them or modify your registration data until the submission deadline. When ready, please upload your abstract in the section "Submit Abstracts".

- The content of the abstract should be original and directly related to the research activities of your hosting laboratory.

- Please state the topic in which their abstract must be included during the application process. Topics included:

- AI and machine learning/omics
- Tumour cell dormancy and plasticity
- Tumour- microenvironment crosstalk
- Imaging and monitoring tumour burden
- Precision immunotherapy
- New frontiers in treatment/Precision medicine

- The **presenting author** must be a member of ASEICA. New ASEICA membership applicants will be also accepted. Abstracts will be only accepted upon **full registration** in the 18th ASEICA International Congress.

- Upon submission, you will receive an email by **October 24th** indicating if the abstract is accepted and whether it has been selected as either a poster or an oral communication.

The deadline for the first author to confirm the presentation of the project is **October 27th**.

- The first author must convey this information to the rest of collaborators.

- We inform you that the abstracts presented in the **III Encuentro de Jóvenes Investigadores del CIBERONC (IIEJI)** contest, can also be presented in the ASEICA International Congress.

If you wish to do so, please the registration of these abstracts must be done following the process described in the rules of the Aseica contest.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS:

- All communications should be written in **English**.
- The title should be no longer than 20 words.
(Do not write the title or authors on the space reserved for the abstract body)
- The body of the abstract should contain a brief introduction, objectives, methods, results, and main conclusions (5,000 characters maximum).
- You can add graphical content (graphs, images, tables, etc.). This should be uploaded as a separate file with a limitation of 2MB.
- Select the category in which the abstract should be classified.
- Authors: please enter the first author in the first place (this will be the contact person for the ASEICA Technical Secretariat)

This **LINK** must be used to submit your Abstract.

RULES ON POSTERS

- If your abstract has been chosen as a poster, you must bring it printed on the **27th November 2022** (early morning).
- The size of the poster must be **120 cm high and 90 cm wide**.
- In the congress you will find an abstract list with the main authors' names and the number assigned to the scientific abstract.
- The posters will be exhibited during the entire duration of the Symposium.
- Authors should remain next to their posters during the "Poster sessions" that will be indicated on the programme.

RULES ON ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

- Six abstracts will be selected to be presented during the Symposium.
- The first author will be the person in charge of making the presentation in English during the Symposium.
- The speaker will have 10 minutes for the abstract presentation and then 5 minutes for Q&A.
- Those selected will have to send in advance the presentation (slides) of their lectures. Deadline to send the PowerPoint: **November 10th**
- Only slides in PowerPoint format will be accepted.
